India has significantly influenced the global agricultural economy by becoming the world's second-largest rice producer and ranking among the top 15 leading agricultural exporters worldwide. In the fiscal year 2024-25, India exported approximately 18 million tonnes of rice valued at over \$11 billion and around 4.5 million tonnes of wheat worth approximately \$1.3 billion. The country's total agricultural exports are projected to exceed \$50 billion in FY25, up from \$50.21 billion in FY22, reflecting steady growth despite global challenges. India continues to move toward its long-term goal of reaching \$100 billion in agriexports by 2030, supported by favorable government policies and rising global demand.

# **Indian Rice & Grain Industry Market Drives**

- Development in Rice, Wheat, and Cereal Exports: India's rice and grain exports saw significant growth from FY 2023-2024 to FY 2024-2025. Non-Basmati rice exports increased by approximately 21%, from 45,650 crore (US\$ 6124 million) in FY 2023 to an estimated ₹55,000 crore (US\$ 7000 million) in FY 2025. Basmati rice exports reached a new high of 63,000 crore (US\$ 7900 million) during FY 2024-2025, fueled by strong global demand and the removal of export restrictions. In total, India exported over 1.2 lakh crore (US\$ 15 billion) worth of rice alone, contributing significantly to the global rice market.
- India's wheat and other cereal exports also saw an uptick, with wheat exports reaching approximately 15,000 crore (US\$ 1800 million) in FY 2024-2025. The increased demand for cereals, particularly from African and Middle Eastern nations, helped boost India's position as a key exporter of wheat globally.
- Government Initiatives and Funding: The Indian government has continued its robust support for the agricultural sector with significant funding and initiatives. In FY 2024-25, the Ministry of Food Processing Industries allocated ₹4,500 crore (US\$ 600 million) for agricultural infrastructure and food processing sector development. The government also approved 100% FDI in food product marketing and e-commerce, encouraging foreign investment in the agricultural value chain
- Additionally, the government has committed ₹10,000 crore (US\$ 1.2 billion) in funding under the SAMPADA scheme for the
  development of mega food parks and agro-processing clusters. This is part of its ongoing plan to increase the food
  processing sector's contribution to the economy, aiming to increase the capacity to 15% of total agricultural production by
  FY 2027.
- Methodologies for Accelerating the Processes: The Product Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for food processing continues to support the sector with an outlay of 12,000 crore (US\$ 1.5 billion) for FY 2024-2025, encouraging food processing units to expand capacity and invest in branding and marketing abroad. The government aims to boost exports and create strong Indian food brands with incentives for the next five years, beginning in FY 2024.
- The Digital Agriculture Mission for 2021-2025 has also accelerated with additional funding, focusing on integrating new technologies like remote sensing, artificial intelligence, blockchain, GIS, and drones to improve productivity and ensure traceability in agricultural supply chains.
